My name is JD Garcia, I am over 18 years of age, of sound mind, capable of making this affidavit, and personally acquainted with the facts herein stated:


I am a State Certified Residential Real Estate Appraiser number TX-1324990-R and have held this same Certification since March 30, 1993.


