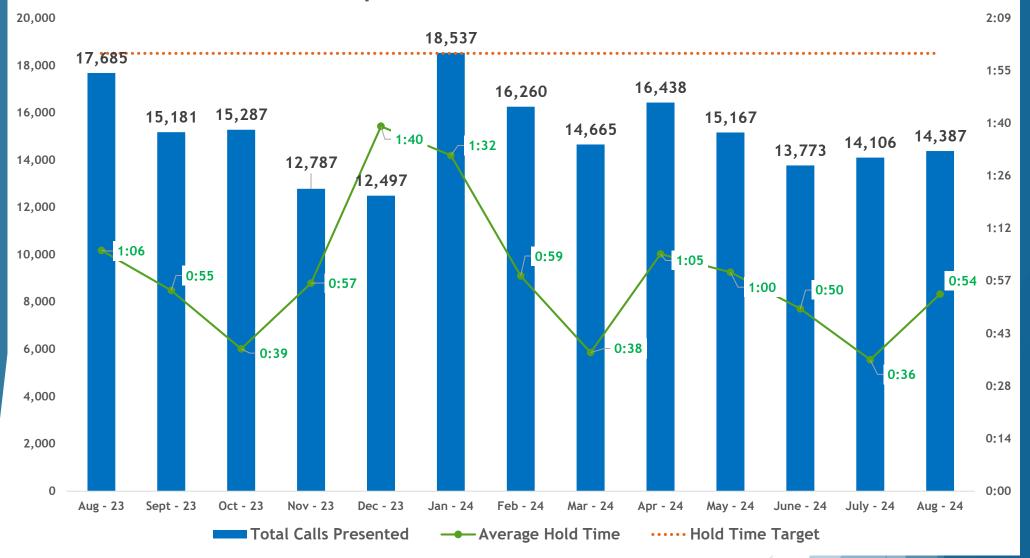

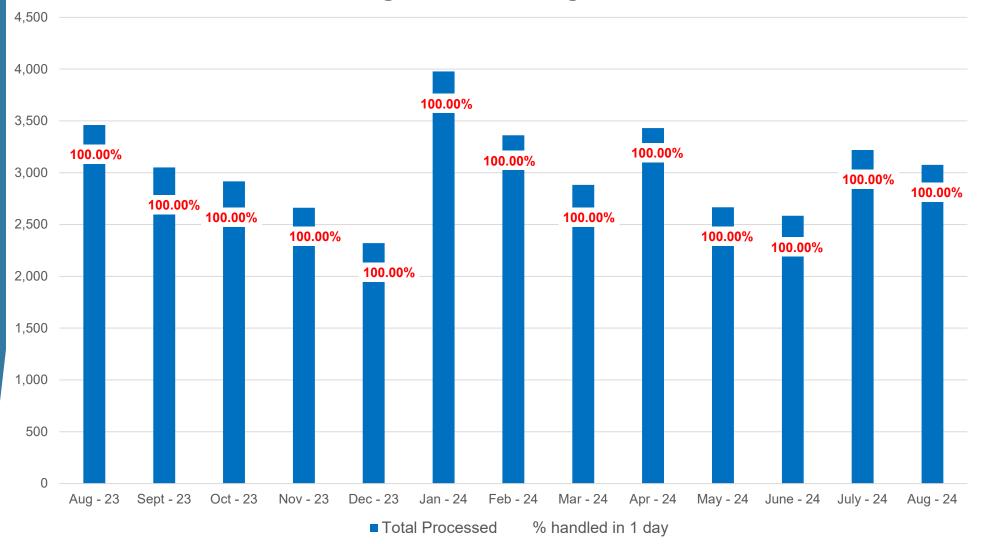
# Customer Relation Division 13 Month Comparison of Calls Presented vs. Hold Time

13 Month Comparison of Emails Processed August, 2023 to August, 2024

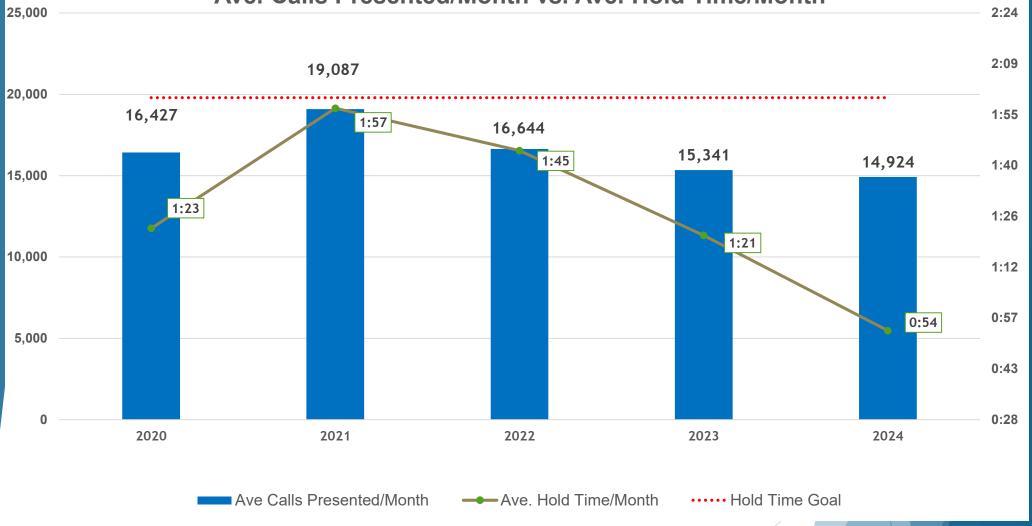

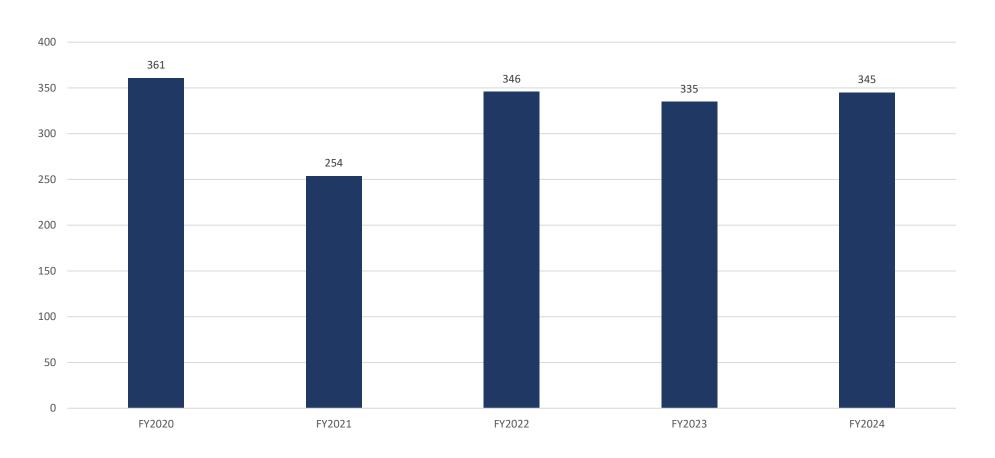

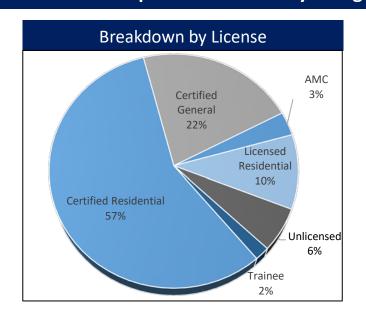


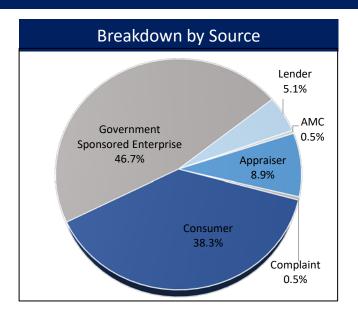




#### **Fiscal Year 2024 Complaints Received by Category**

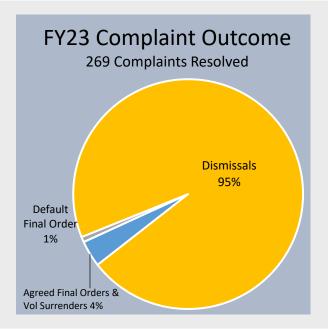


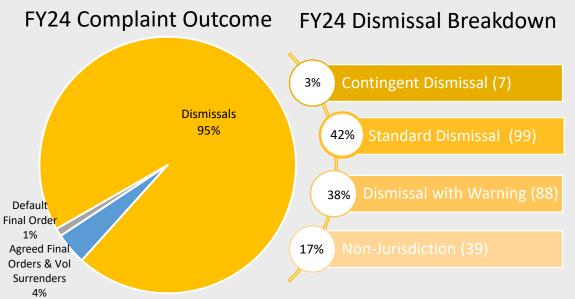

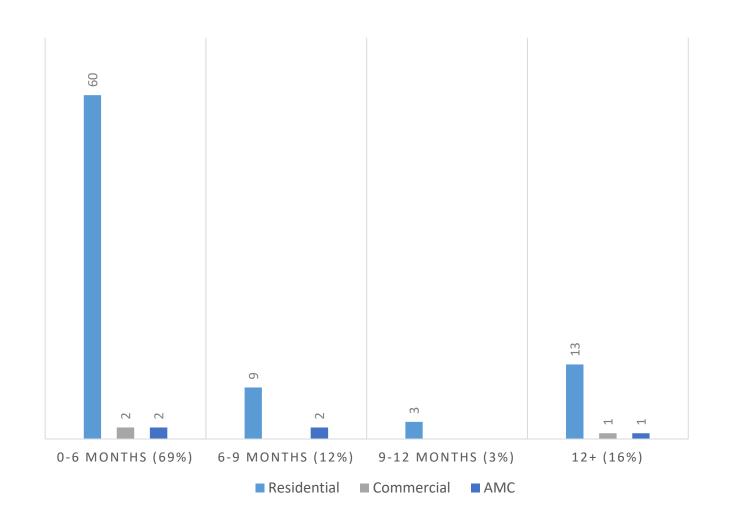
